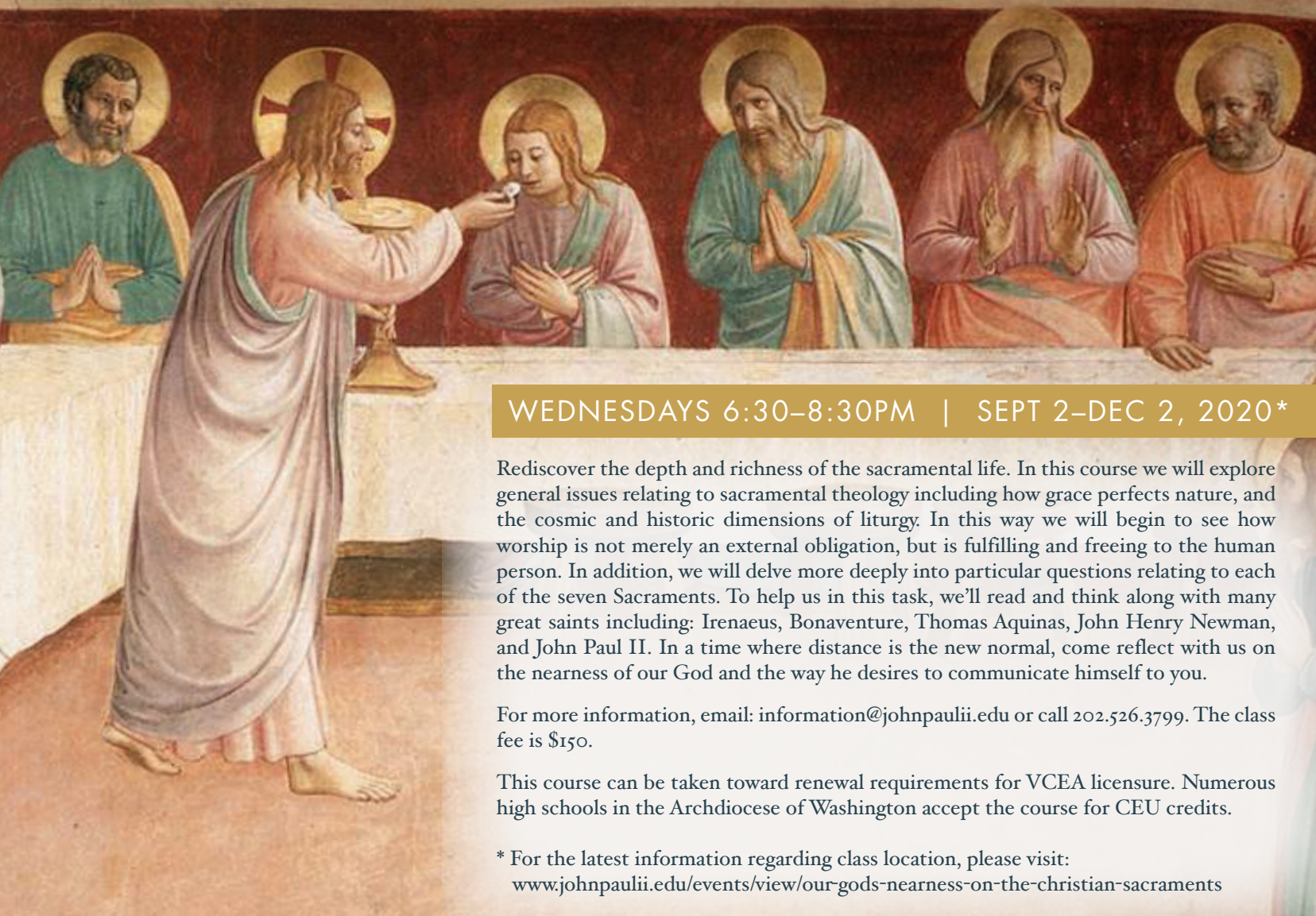


FALL 2020 CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSE

Rediscover the depth and richness of the sacramental life. In this course we will explore general issues relating to sacramental theology including how grace perfects nature, and the cosmic and historic dimensions of liturgy. In this way we will begin to see how worship is not merely an external obligation, but is fulfilling and freeing to the human person. In addition, we will delve more deeply into particular questions relating to each of the seven Sacraments. To help us in this task, we'll read and think along with many great saints including: Irenaeus, Bonaventure, Thomas Aquinas, John Henry Newman, and John Paul II. In a time where distance is the new normal, come reflect with us on the nearness of our God and the way he desires to communicate himself to you.
